

Post-Election 2020 Update, 9 March 2020 – PLEASE SHARE

Keep Defects on the Agenda – Email your TDs Now!

Since the Construction Defects Alliance was last in touch with you, the new Dáil has met twice and is not due to meet again until Thursday, 19 March after St Patrick's Day.

However, particularly given the threat posed by the Corona virus, it is thought that the pace of efforts to form a new Government will speed up then with intensive and more detailed talks getting underway.

Before such talks get underway, it would be helpful if you and your neighbours emailed or rang your local TDs to thank them for their support and to urge them to ensure that the Safe As Houses? report – which proposes redress for owners of defective apartments is introduced.

So please take this simple action now and get your friends, families and neighbours to do so too. It's an easy way to ensure that the defects which affect you are kept front and centre with all members of the 33rd Dáil.

Preparing for Government Negotiations

Over recent weeks, the Construction Defects Alliance has been working with the Apartment Owners' Network and construction experts to prepare more detailed proposals on redress for those affected by apartment defects as well as ensuring that such defects are minimised into the future. We expect the work to be finished this week so that the proposals will be ready for the Alliance to engage more intensively with those who will be negotiating the next Programme for Government over the coming weeks.
