## Tax Returns

All self-employed people are required to complete their 2022 tax returns by Wednesday, 15 November next.

In this context, self-employed landlords should note that they can write any service charges and remediation levies off against their tax liability.

Indeed, if you fall into this category, and haven't written such costs off before, you can actually go back as far as 2019 to do so in this tax return.

Unfortunately, the ability to recover such costs does not apply to PAYE workers and this is why we are working to get remediation levies reimbursed for such owners and we are hopeful of progress on this next year.
