Preliminary Talks

Now that all 160 members of the 33rd Dáil have been returned, preliminary talks have begun about government formation.

The new Dáil will meet for the first time next week but a Government will not be in place by then, in fact, it's likely that all that will be known by then – at the most – is who could possibly be in the mix to form a Government.

Discussions on a new Programme for Government will take some weeks – last time it took around eight weeks after the election and there's no reason to think it will be any less this time.

However, the Construction Defects Alliance has already been in touch with key spokespersons and we are in the process of preparing more detailed proposals for those who get involved in the negotiation process.

We will also want you to reconnect with all newly elected TDs and, in this regard, we will be preparing an email that you can send to them. More on this next week.
